

Important Things I Need to Do in 2008

- _____ Make sure I have at least 12 inches of insulation in my attic. (Add cellulose insulation if necessary.)
- _____ Insulate my basement walls, crawl space and box sills with P2000 insulation.
- _____ Replace as many of my incandescent light bulbs with compact fluorescent light bulbs. (Check out the different styles.)
- _____ Seal all my utility entrances, foundation cracks, window and door frames with caulk or foam.
- _____ Install a high-efficiency air-source heat pump or geothermal system to heat and cool my home.
- _____ Install an electric water heater. (It may be cheaper than using propane.)
- _____ Contact the Eastern Illini marketing department for a heating cost analysis.
- _____ Compare the different rate options I have with Eastern Illini.
- _____ Check out Eastern Illini's Web site and all the things I can do to become energy wise.
- _____ Call Eastern Illini and ask about their Energy-Wise low interest loan program.
