OPTIONAL GENERAL SERVICE - SINGLE-PHASE - SUMMER/WINTER
RATE SCHEDULE NO. 19

Availability

Available upon application to all member/owners for all uses, including lighting, heating, and power, subject to established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Service under this schedule requiring more than 75 kVA of transformer capacity is subject to approval by the Cooperative on a case-by-case basis. Approval of the Cooperative must be obtained prior to installation of any motor requiring starting current in excess of 260 amperes.

Type of Service

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available voltages.

Rate

Facilities Charge:

\$34.00 per month for service requiring 50 kVA or less of transformer capacity.
For services requiring more than 50 kVA of transformer capacity, the facilities charge shall be increased at a rate of 50 cents for each additional kVA or fraction thereof required

All kilowatt-hours used at the account shall be billed as follows:

Summer Energy Charge: ^[1]

First 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month @ 13.8 cents per kilowatt-hour
Over 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month @ 10.4 cents per kilowatt-hour

Winter Energy Charge: ^[2]

First 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month @ 13.8 cents per kilowatt-hour
Over 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month @ 7.9 cents per kilowatt-hour

Minimum Charge

The monthly minimum charge under this rate shall be the sum of the Facilities Charge and Energy Charges.

¹ Applies during the monthly billing period ending in June of each year and the following three consecutive monthly billing periods.

² Applies during all other monthly billing periods.

Notwithstanding any provisions of this rate schedule with respect to minimum charges, the Cooperative may adjust the monthly minimum charge to assure adequate revenue for amortization of its investment in distribution facilities.

Utility Taxes

Any tax and fees levied on the Cooperative under the Illinois Public Utilities Revenue Act shall be added to the rates and minimum charges specified in this schedule. Any additional taxes that may be imposed by taxing authorities on the member/owner shall also be added to the above rates and minimum charges.

Temporary Service

Temporary service will be supplied in accordance with this rate schedule, except that the Consumer shall pay, in addition to the above charges, the net cost of installing and removing service. A deposit, payable in advance, may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of construction and retirement.

Terms of Payment

The above charges are net, the gross charges being 5 percent higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within 15 days from the date of the bill, the gross charges shall apply.

Effective with bills rendered on and after April 27, 2010.
