OPTIONAL SERVICE THREE-PHASE ELECTRIC HEAT & WATER HEATING
RATE SCHEDULE NO. 8

Availability

Available upon application to any member/owner who has permanently installed and is using an electric heat pump or electric resistance heat as the primary source of space heating and has permanently installed and is using an electric water heater for domestic water heating and for all other uses, including lighting and power, subject to established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. A premise may qualify for this rate if electric resistance heat is used solely in over 75 percent of the inhabitable area or if an electric heat pump is used in conjunction with a fossil fuel furnace and the installation has a balance point setting of 25 degrees or below. The heat pump must be sized for the heating load. This rate is applicable to loads requiring 225 kVA or less of transformer capacity. Three-phase service requiring more than 225 kVA of transformer capacity shall be provided under the Cooperative's Rate Schedule for Large Power Service. The Cooperative shall be the sole and final authority in determining applicability of the rate to an account.

Type of Service

Three-phase and incidental single-phase, 60 cycles, at available voltages.

Rate

Facilities Charge:

\$64.35 per month for services requiring 75 kVA or less of transformer capacity.
For services requiring more than 75 kVA of transformer capacity, the facilities charge shall be increased at a rate of \$1.00 for each additional kVA or fraction thereof.

All kilowatt-hours used at the account shall be billed as follows:

Summer Energy Charge: ^[1]

First 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month @ 13.8 cents per kilowatt-hour
Over 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month @ 10.4 cents per kilowatt-hour

Winter Energy Charge: ^[2]

First 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month @ 13.8 cents per kilowatt-hour
Over 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month @ 6.8 cents per kilowatt-hour

¹ Applies during the monthly billing period ending in June of each year and the following three consecutive monthly billing periods.

² Applies during all other monthly billing periods.

Minimum Charge

The monthly minimum charge under the above rate shall be the sum of the Facilities Charge and Energy Charges.

Notwithstanding any provisions of this rate schedule with respect to minimum charges, the Cooperative may adjust the monthly minimum charge to assure adequate revenue for amortization of its investment in distribution facilities.

Utility Taxes

Any tax and fees levied under the Illinois Public Utilities Revenue Act shall be added to the rates and minimum charges specified in this schedule. Any additional taxes that may be imposed by taxing authorities on the Consumer shall also be added to the above rates and minimum charges.

Terms of Payment

The above charges are net, the gross charges being 5 percent higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within 15 days from the date of the bill, the gross charges shall apply.
