RIDER NO. 1  
INTERRUPTIBLE WATER HEATING

Availability

Available upon application to any member/owner served under Rates 1, 5, 6, 8, 19 or 20 utilizing electricity as the sole source of energy for domestic water heating, subject to established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. The water heater must be a 240-volt unit with a minimum size of 30 gallons that is capable of being cycled off and on by a control device provided and installed by the Cooperative.

The member/owner must agree that the Cooperative can install a radio control switch on an electric water heater(s) and agree that the Cooperative can operate the switch to ensure that the water heater(s) cannot come on during the Cooperative's peak load periods.

Rate

First 500 kilowatt-hours purchased per month - no credit  
Over 500 kilowatt-hours purchased per month - \$4.00 credit for one unit  
Over 1,000 kilowatt-hours purchased per month - \$4.00 credit for a second unit

Member/owners will receive the credit(s) each month if the kilowatt-hour use meets the foregoing minimums.

Notice of and Period of Interruption

The Cooperative is not required to give notice prior to interrupting service to the water heater(s). The period of interruption will be limited to 12 p.m. (noon) to 10 p.m.

Additional Terms

1. The Cooperative shall be the sole and final authority in determining whether this rider is applicable to an account.
2. The Cooperative reserves the right to limit the number of member/owners on this rider to the level required to meet its target of controllable load.
3. The Cooperative shall have no liability to the member/owner and the member/owner shall assume full responsibility for any loss, damage or claim by reason of any interruption, curtailment or restoration of service.
