REGULATION NO. 7

SUBJECT: Continuity of Service

REGULATION:

1. Regularity of Supply

The Cooperative will use reasonable diligence to provide and maintain uninterrupted service. In case of cessation, deficiency, variation in voltages, change in character of energy from three-phase to single-phase, or any other failure or reversal of the service resulting from acts of God, public enemies, accidents, strikes, riots, wars, repairs, orders of courts or other acts reasonably beyond the control of the Cooperative, it shall not be liable for damages, direct or consequential, resulting from such interruption or failure.

2. Notice of Service Problems

The member/owner shall give immediate notice to the office of the Cooperative of any interruption, irregularities, unsatisfactory service and of any hazardous conditions known to the member/owner.

The Cooperative may, at any time it deems necessary, suspend the supply of electrical energy to any member/owner for the purpose of making repairs, changes or improvements upon any part of the system. It shall make reasonable effort to furnish notice of service interruptions to the member/owner when time and circumstances permit.
